Annual Dues for 2024

Membership dues are for the calendar year January 1 through December 31. Beginning January 1, 2024, membership will be increased for Singles to \$25, and for couples \$40. As we have not increased our dues in almost a decade, this minimal increase was determined by the Board as reasonable considering inflation over the past several years.
